Pomegranate is one of the most authentic and traditional symbols. As a gift, as honeycombs from bees, full of purity and beauty, healthy and as one of nature's most perfect creations.

The main lesson we should take about pomegranates is in the way the seeds remain united "shoulder to shoulder". Despite their different shapes and sizes, the seeds rest in perfect union. They are countless and, like us, spread throughout the planet.



The importance of pomegranate is millennial - it appears in biblical texts and the Greeks considered it a symbol of love and fruitfulness. The pomegranate tree was consecrated to the goddess Aphrodite, because people believed in her aphrodisiac powers. For Jews, pomegranate is a religious symbol with deep meaning in the New Year's ritual, as it was considered by them a symbol of fertility.


The pomegranate is also seen as the unit, in the same way as its seeds, always together and providing unparalleled accommodation, welcoming everyone and its grains, immersed in their transparent pulp, symbolize the union with the energy and strength necessary to carry out the work. Pomegranate grains symbolize the union in its various aspects.

The grains grow together in such a way that they lose their natural shape which would be round; squeezed to each other. They are similar to geometric polygons, with several facets; they are glossy and beautiful, resembling the combs of a bee hive; the bees work tirelessly.

Pomegranate expresses reality in its coloration. The crown of triangles or crown of virtue, sacrifice, science, fraternity is placed at one end of the sphere. Symbolizes the crowning of the work. The red flower represents the flame of enthusiasm that leads the learner to his destination, illuminating his journey.
